Tip Box

Biblical fellowship is “participating together in the life and truth made possible by the Holy Spirit through our union with Christ. Fellowship is sharing something in common on the deepest possible level of human relationship—our experience of God himself. *Participating together ... life and truth ... sharing in common ... human relationship ... experience of God.*” From the book, *Why Small Groups?*, P. 21.
